

CALOR | Safe Refuelling of Fork Lift Trucks

Here we've outlined some helpful hints and tips to ensure the safe refilling of LPG cylinders used on forklift trucks.

Training



Any person responsible for, or involved with, the operation and dispensing of LPG should be trained in the operation of the equipment.

Correct PPE

When changing or refilling an LPG cylinder, you will need:



A face shield or visor



Neoprene or nitrile gloves – preferably the gauntlets



A long-sleeved top made from cotton



A high visibility vest

Safety boots



Refilling a cylinder hints and tips

When refuelling a refillable LPG cylinder, you should park a minimum of three metres away from the tanks.



3 Metres

It is important that the filling hose should be inspected prior to use on every occasion, as damaged hoses can result in serious accidents.
