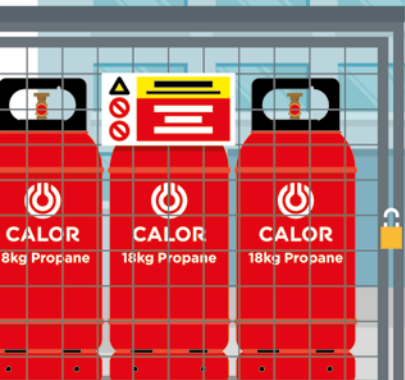




Safe Replacement of Fork Lift Truck Cylinders

Here we've outlined some helpful hints and tips to ensure the safe replacement of LPG cylinders used on forklift trucks.

ABC WAREHOUSING



Training



Any person responsible for, or involved with, the operation and dispensing of LPG should be trained in the operation of the equipment.

Correct PPE

When replacing an LPG cylinder, you will need:



A face shield or visor



Neoprene or nitrile gloves - preferably the gauntlets



Safety boots



A high-visibility vest

A long-sleeved top made from cotton



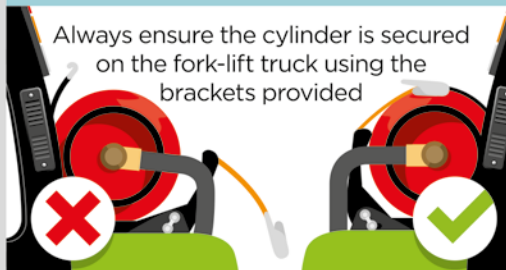
Refilling a cylinder hints and tips



LPG cylinders should always be stored upright on their bases in a well-ventilated position, preferably in the open air.



Storage area to be free of combustible materials and sources of ignition



Always ensure the cylinder is secured on the fork-lift truck using the brackets provided



Any faults identified on cylinders must be reported to your Calor Customer Operations Centre
